Please read, & fill out the form on the reverse side of this letter. The information that you supply is an important part of the association's record keeping. We need these forms returned to the secretary by all our members no matter if there is no change in your personal information or whether you are an Active, Inactive, Honorary or Retiring Member. Junior members can not use this form. Junior Members must use the parental waiver form, & have it signed by their Parent or Legal Guardian.

Please fill out the form completely and legibly. Please pay close attention to your phone numbers and email address when filling out this form. We need your **Legal Name** (the name that appears on your driver's license), your **Date of Birth** (D.O.B.), your **Mailing Address**, the **County** you live in, (i.e. Plymouth, Bristol, Norfolk), your **Cell phone**, & **Home Phone Numbers**, work number is optional, & your main **E-Mail address**, The one that you use most often. If you are using a work or school e-mail address, make sure your security setting are set to accept emails from the association.

Please read the 3 questions on the bottom of the form.

Question 1 is whether or not you will be receiving a Varsity, Junior Varsity, Freshman, or Middle School schedule, you are required to be registered with the (M.I.A.A.) Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletic Association. If you plan umpiring any level of M.I.A.A. sanctioned High School games, you must be registered, by February 24, 2011, if you pay by this date, the S.M.U.A. will pay the registration fee, if paid after that date you will have to register on your own at a cost of \$12.00. If you are not registered with the M.I.A.A. you will not be assigned any school baseball games at any level.

Question 2 is whether you are being registered by another Baseball Association. You only need to be registered once with the M.I.A.A. per year. You should be register by your main Baseball Umpires Association. Being registered by multiple associations will not get you more games, it is just a waste of money. So if you are being registered by another baseball association other than the S.M.U.A. Please check off the box. Remember if you are also working another spring sport (Softball, Lacrosse, Track, or Volleyball) you must register separately for those sports.

Question 3 is weather or not you are sending your dues to either the Treasurer, Pay Pal, or to the post office box. Those that send it to the post office box it will be forwarded to the treasurer. We just need to know where it is being sent to, so we do not lose any payments. Remember dues are \$45.00 for Active members; \$25.00 for Inactive Members, there are no dues owed for any Honorary Members or Executive Board Members.

Please do not for get to sign, & date your information release. If it is not signed we can not run a background check on you or register you with the M.I.A.A. and you will not be assigned any baseball games at any level.
