In Accordance to the S.M.U.A. Constitution, Article III, Section 3: To qualify for regular membership, a candidate shall pass a written exam, and attend a field mechanics clinic. Said candidate shall serve a probationary period of two (2) years. During which time the candidate shall **NOT** umpire at the high school varsity, or junior legion levels. Failure to meet these requirements will result in a suspension, and all high school commissioners, the M.B.U.A., and the M.I.A.A. will be notified. To requalify for membership, you will have to retake the exams, and pay the clinic fee.
